1. Events and Championships

Grampian Automobile Club Ltd will promote four National 'B' status Speed Hillclimb Meetings at Fintray House, Dyce, Aberdeen on Sat 7 and Sun 8 May 2005 and on Sat 13 and Sun 14 August 2005 and a National 'B' status Sprint meeting at Grampian Transport Museum, Alford on Sunday 17 July 2005.

The Meetings will be held under the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association Ltd (incorporating the provision of the International Sporting code of the FIA), these supplementary Regulations and any written Instructions that the organising Club may issue for an Event.

Judges of Fact will be appointed to :

The Start Line Judges of Fact will be the Chief Timekeeper and the Senior Start Line Marshal. The Sound and Speed Judge of Fact will be the Environmental Scrutineer.

5. Entries

Entries are invited from Grampian Automobile Club Members, Registered Competitors for the Scottish Sprint and Scottish Hillclimb Championships and members of Scottish Motor Clubs affiliated to the MSA.

The Maximum entry for each meeting at Fintray is 120.

The Maximum entry for each Meeting at Alford is 60.

The Minimum entry for each Meeting is 40.

The minimum entry for each class is 5. Should any of the above minimum figures not be reached the organisers have the right to cancel the Meeting or amalgamate the Classes.

Newcomers (as defined in the regulations for the Scottish Hillclimb Championships). In order to encourage newcomers to the sport the club are offering a half price entry fee for registered newcomers entering their first Grampian Automobile Club event. Please mark the 'Newcomer' section clearly on the entry form.

Each competitor must complete an entry form for each event and send these together with a cheque for the correct entry fee before the closing dates listed below.

Entries will be acknowledged in the Final Instructions sent to each Competitor prior to the Specific Meeting.

Late entries will only be accepted if numbers permit and will be subject to a surcharge of £10 above the entry fee.

6. Refund of Entry Fee/Cancellation of Event

A Competitor notifying the Entries Secretary in writing of their non-attendance in excess of 2 days prior to the Event will be entitled to a full refund subject to a discretionary £5 administration fee. Should the Event be cancelled the Entry Fee will be refunded in full.

Should a competitor entering for both Saturday and Sunday meetings at Fintray suffer a breakdown on the first day which is beyond repair, the entry fee for the second day will be refunded only if the Secretary of the Meeting is notified before the end of the Saturday event and this is backed up by written confirmation from the Chief Scrutineer.

Classes for any other cars (e.g.single make) are invited and may be included should enough entries be received, but this will remain at the discretion of the Stewards of the Meeting.

6.1. Vehicle Definition

A. Road Cars

Are production vehicles that are fully equipped for road use. Within the Road Car division , the Classic & Thoroughbred Car class is open to cars manufactured prior to 1 January 1976 or of a type that was in production prior to that date

Marque Road Sports Cars includes Standard production Road Cars from classic marque clubs (including MG, Austin Healey, Triumph, Jaguar, TVR, Morgan, Ginetta, Lotus, Porsche and Ferrari).

B. Modified Cars

Are cars as defined by the requirements of section L12 of the current MSA yearbook as Modified Production Cars and includes two seater cars not complying with classes in Division A (Road Cars) as defined in these regulations provided that modifications and safety regulations for Modified Production Cars are adhered to.

Group B Sports Cars, GT1 Sports Cars and World Rally Cars will run in the Competition Car Division and in the appropriate Sports Libre class.

C. Competition Cars

This section includes cars from the Sports Libre, Hillclimb Supersports , Racing Car and FF1600 Classes

7. Parking of Trailers and Non Competition Cars/Paddock Safety

Trailers and non competing cars are not allowed within the Paddock area during Practice or Competition unless under the instruction of the Clerk of the Course. For safety, permission will only be given in extreme cases and then only under the supervision of an official. All vehicles driven within the paddock or public areas must be driven at a slow speed at all times. Handbrake turns and similar manoeuvres are prohibited.

At Fintray there will be no entry to the venue after the start of the event and competitors are asked to keep 'pit crew' vehicles to a minimum. Competitors are asked not to leave the venue during the event unless in an emergency- and only when authorised by the Clerk of the Course. This is for your own safety and the safety of others.

9. Scrutineering/Documentation

Scrutineering will take place in situ after a Competitor has 'signed on' with the Competitor in attendance and will be divided into two Sections. In addition to the normal check for race-worthiness, there may be a separate examination for eligibility. Both these examinations will take place before the start of each Meeting, although additional checks may be made during or after the Meeting. Race Overalls, Crash Helmet and MSA Log Book (not 'Road' Classes) will be examined at Scrutineering.

At 'Signing On' Competitors must produce:

1. Competition Licence valid for the Event - minimum National Speed B
2. Valid Club Membership Card
3. For 'Road' Classes, Certificate of Insurance, MoT Certificate

Any Scrutineer may also request production of the Documents

10. Awards

Fastest Time of the Day

Fastest Road Car

1st in Class, with further Awards per complete five competitors.

No award will be made in classes with only one competitor.

Further Awards in Class may be awarded at the discretion of the Organisers of the Meeting.

The Competitors gaining the Fastest Time of the Day, and Fastest Road Card Awards shall not be eligible for Class Awards. Any Award not collected at the respective Awards Presentation may be forfeit

11. Signing of Competition Licences for Upgrading

Competitors wishing their Competition Licence signed by the Clerk of the Course for upgrading should hand the Licence to the Secretary of the Meeting at 'Signing On'. Licences not signed by, and not displaying a current photograph of the holder will not receive an upgrading signature.

12. Competition Numbers

Competition numbers must be clearly displayed according to current MSA Regulations. Competition vehicles 'double entered' and therefore displaying two sets of competition numbers, must display the respective number for the driver for practice and competition runs. Re-runs will not normally be given to driver/vehicle combinations incorrectly identified. Numbers will be available to purchase from the Secretary of the Meeting.

13. Walking the Course

Competitors who have not previously competed at the venue, **MUST** identify themselves to the Secretary of the Meeting at 'Signing On' and will be required to walk the Course under the supervision of a suitable person nominated by the Clerk of the Course.

14. Tyre Warming/Tyre Warming Area

The use of any external device or power source to pre-heat the tyres of a competition vehicle, whether the tyres are fitted to that vehicle or not, is prohibited. This does not affect the right of a competitor to spin the wheels to induce heat into the tyres in the area designated for this purpose, but forward direction must be maintained. The tyre warming area at Fintray is designated by a white line across the track and a 'Tyre Warming Area' sign

15. Start/Finish

Cars will start singly, the starting signal being a green light. Timing starts when the competition vehicle interrupts a light beam. The Finish Line will be indicated by a banner and/or a white line.

16. Timing Struts

Competitors are reminded that a Timing Strut is required in accordance with L 10.12.1 for all Events detailed herein.

17. Red Flag

Competitors are reminded that during practice and competition, if the red flag is displayed, they **MUST** stop as soon as reasonably practicable and **REMAIN STATIONARY UNTIL INSTRUCTED OTHERWISE BY A Marshal or Official of the Event.** A Competitor so stopped will be offered a further run.

18. Results

Results will be displayed at the Secretary's Office as soon as possible after each practice or competitive run, and will be published and forwarded to each competitor as soon as possible after the Event.

19. Conduct of the Meeting

Any query/complaint regarding the running of the Meeting should be addressed to the Clerk of the Course ONLY. Individual Officials should not be approached.

20. Protests

Protests must be lodged in accordance with Section 0 5.1.2 of the 2004 MSA Yearbook.

21. 2005 Club Championship Competition Regulations

- a. All current Grampian Automobile Club Members are eligible for this Competition
- b. Scoring shall be against a Class 'Bogey Time' which will be the existing Class Record prior to the Meeting.
- c. Where a class record does not exist prior to the meeting the new record will be the one set at the first event of the season at that venue. Points will be awarded as a percentage of this class record.
The winner shall be deemed the Club Champion. Should there be a tie situation, the Competitor scoring the higher points in round 1 shall be placed first.
- c. Championship rounds for 2005 are as follows
Round 1 /2- Fintray House Hill Climb 7/8 May
Round 3 - Alford Sprint 17 July
Round 4/5 - Fintray House Hill Climb 13/14 August All Rounds count towards the Championship
- f. The best times in Class as gained on the day(Practice and Main Competition runs) will be used for this Competition
- g. At the discretion of the Committee, an Award may be presented to an Official or Marshal giving outstanding service throughout the year.

Venues

Fintray

Fintray House Hillclimb is situated on the B977 Dyce to Hatton of Fintray road. The competitors entrance will be well signposted off this road. When entering the estate please proceed slowly along the drive. It may be necessary for some cars with trailers to drive round the track to gain access to the paddock from the top entrance and this must be done slowly and quietly so as not to disturb the land owners or endanger officials and competitors walking on the track. Anyone driving above 20mph on the track before the event start may be eliminated from the competition

Alford

The village of Alford is situated on the A944 approx. 26miles west of Aberdeen. Grampian Transport Museum is well signposted off the main street. Paddock space is limited so all competitors should follow the paddock marshals instructions and trailers should be removed from the paddock area as soon as they are unloaded. Remember that entries are strictly limited at Alford so to ensure a place send your entry in early.

Camping

Please note that overnight camping is NOT permitted at either venue. Anyone wishing to camp or caravan for any event is welcome to do so at Milton of Fintray which is just about a mile from the hillclimb venue. Please let Anne Smith know if you wish to camp or caravan.
